


Kinbrook Connection PATHWAY PARTNERSHIP





Partnerships & Pathways

For many years, residents of Brooks and the County of Newell have desired a pathway that connects the City of Brooks with one of the Region's most treasured assets, Lake Newell.

The project was proposed again in 2020 and this time, regional partners were all on board and ready to make a commitment. In 2021, an endorsement from the Eastern Irrigation District, plus a large municipal funding pledge, provided the momentum needed to make this dream a reality. Community members and municipal partners are excited to see the pathway through to fruition and provide a legacy project for residents and tourists to enjoy for many years.





The Route

Welcome to the **Kinbrook Connection Pathway**, a multi-functional, shared trail which will link to the existing pathway network in the City of Brooks. The pathway will stretch for a total of twelve kilometres exposing users to lake views, natural grasslands and prairies, shorebird habitat and some amazing sunrises and sunsets.

- o Starting at the County Administration Building, the pathway heads straight south towards Township Road 182.
- o The path cuts south across the prairie towards Lake Newell, goes along the shoreline, and eventually crosses the Bantry Canal. It will run along the canal back to the lake and the Bantry Bay subdivision.
- o From Bantry Bay, the path winds along the shoreline, with lake views to the west and prairie views to the east.
- o Finally, the trail will connect to Kinbrook Island Provincial Park through the established Marsh Trail.

Aside from an active transportation route bringing residents/tourists between Brooks and Kinbrook Island Provincial Park, the pathway could be used for recreational events and activities such as races or birdwatching. There is also potential for future expansion off the main pathway to other locations in the County of Newell.



Sponsorship Opportunities




Platinum Sponsorship - \$100,000+

Platinum level sponsors make contributions of more than \$100,000 and will be prominently featured through signage on the pathway along with appropriate media recognition. Additional logo/brand placement opportunities for Platinum Sponsors may also be available.

Gold Sponsorship - \$25,000 - \$99,999

Gold Sponsors will make a financial or in-kind donation ranging from \$25,000 up to \$99,999. Companies and organizations in the Gold sponsorship level will receive recognition through signage and/or other appropriate measures.



Silver Sponsorship - \$5,000 - \$24,999

The Silver sponsorship level includes contributions with a value between \$5,000 and \$24,999. Silver Sponsors may wish to donate a specific structure, such as a sunshade or bridge, and have their name/logo placed on that item.

Bronze Sponsorship - \$500 - \$4,999

The Bronze level of sponsorship includes financial and in-kind donations ranging from \$500 up to \$4,999. Donors may choose to sponsor a specific item, such as a bench, within this cost range.

These may include financial donations, in-kind support, a commitment towards ongoing maintenance, or acting as a volunteer for the planning process. 


Sponsorship Terms
